Ray Ritenour, Dan Okrup, and Harold Neukom should be recognized as outstanding performers throughout the year and should boost the varsity hope next year.

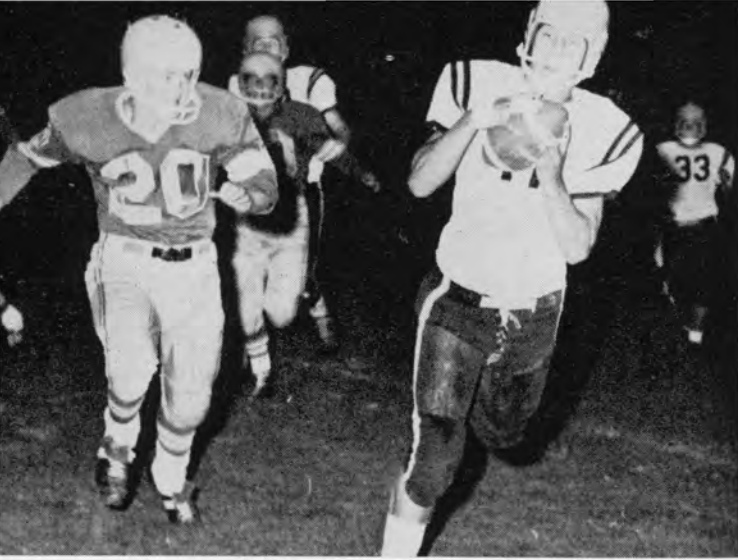
